

# Conference Dress Code



## Professional Attire

Friday and Saturday general sessions, and House of Delegates

**Males** Shirt and tie, slacks (*no shorts or jeans*) with appropriate shoes (*no tennis shoes, flip flops or sandals*). The wearing of a sports coat is encouraged but not required.

**Females** Dresses or pantsuits with appropriate shoes (*no tennis shoes, flip flops*) Dress sandals are OK. The following are not appropriate: skirts shorter than 4 inches above the knee, a dress or blouse which is backless, strapless or that has spaghetti straps or that is exposing the midriff.

## Business Casual

Educational Forums, Meet the Candidates & Lieutenant Governor Elections

**Males** Collared shirts (golf shirts), Polo shirts, crew neck, slacks (*no jeans or shorts*) with appropriate shoes (*no tennis shoes, flip flops or sandals*)

**Females** Collared or collarless blouses, slacks, skorts, skirts that observe the 4 inch rule (*no jeans or shorts*) with appropriate shoes (*no tennis shoes*)

## Casual

Registration, Thursday General Session, dances, and pre- and post-Conference activities

**Male and Female** Modest shorts, jeans, collared shirts, sweatshirts or appropriate tee shirts. Tops with spaghetti straps, midriff exposed tops or tube tops are not appropriate. Clothing with offensive language, sexually oriented material or drug or alcohol related subject matter is not appropriate for our conference at any time. Sandals and tennis shoes or flip flops can be worn with casual attire.

**ADVISORS:** Please discuss this dress code with your students. Many uncomfortable situations can be averted if the students are aware of these dress code expectations prior to their arrival. Your cooperation in this matter is greatly appreciated. You are able to set the tone of these events with your students.
